Introduction

Highlands Riding Tours, Ecuador
Come explore 'The Volcano Avenue': a region surrounded by eleven volcanoes!

Uniquely, the only form of transportation during your trip will be your horse. They will be your partner throughout this adventure. We will thoroughly explore and experience the grandeur of the Andes from the west to the east mountain chain, marveling at the diversity of flora, fauna, and landscape. And, of course, you will have the opportunity to admire the majestic Cotopaxi, the highest active volcano on earth.

Indeed, you will come to appreciate the tradition and customs of the chagras' abilities. In their goat-skin chaps and woolen ponchos, they welcome tourists and demonstrate their centuries-old tradition of herding cattle. The chagras' skill on horseback and knowledge of the landscape legendary. We will ride through the Andean paramo, an ecosystem which encompasses a vast expanse of 12,500 square kilometers. We follow rolling hills of high-altitude grassland dotted with little flowers that have adapted furry leaves to protect themselves from the cold, and ravines that create micro-climates that sprout a surprising variety of life. It is a wondrous place for both new and experienced visitors.

After we have prepared for the main part of the ride, we shall start towards the mighty Cotopaxi. We will visit the colourful animal and produce market of Machachi on our way where you can enjoy the unique beauty of an Andean market as well as have the opportunity to buy any handcraft or leather-work you find interesting. We will then continue our trip to Cotopaxi, the tallest active volcano in the world (5,987m). As we ride through the Andes Mountains, you will experience a diversity of geographical landscapes and climates. Be prepared for a period of intense equatorial sun followed by chilly Andes' wind—all within the space of a few hours. The locals say that the highlands experience all four seasons within the same day.

With our sturdy and well-trained horses, we climb to altitudes exceeding 12,000 feet (4,200m) and ride down to hidden valleys, where we are able to experience the exhilaration of full gallops at high altitudes. It is in these valleys of Machachi where men, shaped by the land together with their horses, have tamed the wild bulls and produced the culture of the paramo, a world apart. Long after our return and the end of our journey, our memories of this rugged but beautiful world will linger as a life-time ride.

Hacienda La Alegria

The Hacienda was built in 1910 in Franco Italian Style and has been renovated and restored. It is made out of adobe and stones and its walls are over 80 cm thick! It is nestled amidst lush surroundings in the typical fertile and green farmland of the Ecuadorian inter Andean plain at an altitude of 2880m (9449 ft). The Hacienda is a family-run organic farm and the hospitality of the Espinosa household is remarked upon by visitors who return year after year. You will be welcomed with a roaring log fire in the sitting room, and in your bedroom when the nights are cold. The farm can accommodate up to 24 people both in the farmhouse and a recently completed extension. The extension has been tastefully restored with solid cypress floors and beams and modern en-suite bathrooms with plenty of hot water and powerful showers. Split-level family rooms sleep five comfortably. Wi-fi internet is available at this property.

Hacienda Bomboli

This property offers basic accommodation for up to 16 guests. It is set in a beautiful rainforest and each room has its own bathroom with hot water. Due to its remote location, cell phone service is very limited and there is no electricity. The house is kept warm and lit with fireplaces and candles and your hosts even puts a warm water bottle in your bed before you go to sleep.

Tambopaxi Refuge in El Boliche

This mountain lodge has adopted the traditional architecture style of the paramo houses in order to reduce its impact on the environment. There is a main cabin with 4 bedrooms (total of 32 beds) and shared bathrooms plus an independent upgraded cabin with 6 bedrooms, each with its own bathroom. Each room has its own heating systems, permanent hot water and good insulation systems allowing you to enjoy a warm, comfortable atmosphere while you rest under a soft, fluffy eiderdown.

Room Occupancy

Single supplement is mandatory as we cannot find another rider to share.



Meals

All meals are included.

Meals are featuring delicious, gourmet international, and Ecuadorian food. You will never go hungry with 3-4 courses offered per meal. Soups are a specialty in the highlands that we will use to warm our bodies after a good ride. Main courses can be chicken, pork, beef, trout, tilapia, pasta and more. Don't forget to save room for dessert!

This trip includes some wine/ beer with dinner.

Riding





Horses

Our horses are very important to us. We have more than 35 riding-horses as well as about 30 mares and foals. Most have been bred here on the farm from mixed Criollo (native South American), English Thoroughbred and Arabian stock, resulting in a near perfect combination of toughness, agility, calm temperament and "mountain sense". Beginners and experienced riders alike have found them easy to ride, willing and good mannered. We are happy to follow the Natural Horsemanship principles when training our horses.

Tack

There is a range of tack including North American style, English style, McClellan cavalry, Chilean and traditional Ecuadorian "Chagra" style with its intricate leatherwork and saddle horn.

Host

Your host Gabriel comes from a family steeped in equestrian tradition. His grandfather bred racing horses close to Quito and his father, was a keen polo player. Gabriel and Paty's three daughters are all keen riders, and the enthusiasm of the whole family is reflected in the quality of the horses at the farm. We are proud to share that Gabriel was recently nominated as MAESTRO GUIA ECUESTRE – there are currently only 3 in the world with this title.

Test Ride

Before starting our program, riders receive instruction and ride under strict surveillance by the guides and helpers. We start by riding in a circle where riders must demonstrate their confidence and ability to adapt to the horse, saddle, and equipment. After this, they move up to a larger arena (70x70 meters/200x200 feet), where they will be observed and guided before going out. The rider has the option to switch horses, saddle, or equipment upon request.

Sample Itinerary: Volcano Cotopaxi Adventure - *subject to changes*

Day 1: Arrival

Arrive to the Hacienda early morning (around 9:30am) if you would like the option to ride for 2 or 3 hours.

Riding: 2-3 hours

Meals included: Lunch & Dinner

Overnight at Hacienda La Alegria

Day 2: Acclimatize

Ride in the arena and get acquainted with the horses and tack that we will use during the ride. We then ride around the neighboring Haciendas. Our first experiences at altitude starts this first day. Lunch in the Hacienda house, visit the milking barn and aging cheese cave, and enjoy the hot tub and fireplace.

Riding: 4 hours

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Overnight at Hacienda La Alegria

Day 3: Cloud Forest

Crossing extensive pastures and eucalyptus forests, we will have a nice view of the "Volcano Avenue". From there, we can appreciate the green and fertile Machachi Valley and we can also see the routes we will take the next day at the east mountain chain. We will ascend the Corazon Volcano up to 4,000 meters and descend through the Cloud forest reserve. At the cloud forest, we will be able to observe a great biodiversity of plants and flowers including giant guneras, orchids, and birds such as the turkey of the forest. In the afternoon we will arrive to Hacienda Bomboli at 3,000m by teatime. Time to put up your feet and relax by the fireplace as you watch the sunset and the lights of the villages near the coast. We enjoy a great meal by our hosts.

Day 4: Hacienda La Alegria

In the morning, we will walk around Hacienda gardens to learn about orchids and cloud forest plants. Arrive to Hacienda La Alegria for lunch, relax, and enjoy the hot tub and the fireplace.

Day 5: Ruminahui Volcano

We ride to the west mountain range and through the valley toward Machachi. We stop at the Machachi market on Sundays. We continue toward the Ruminahui and stop at a beautiful Hacienda for a snack. Afterwards, we keep riding until we arrive to the Pedregal valley and stay overnight in a Hacienda at 3,500 meters.

Riding: 6 hours

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Overnight at Hacienda at Pedregal Valley (near Cotopaxi National Park)

Day 6: The Park

We enter the Cotopaxi National Park and ride towards the Sincholagua volcano, making a large loop downhill to the valley. After a break and a snack, we continue crossing the different lava flows to ascend up to 4,100m to the highest plains of Cotopaxi, where we complete the highest canter in the world. We ride in close proximity to berber wild horse herds that live in the park who are descendants of the horses brought by the Spanish in the 16th century.

Riding: 6+ hours

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Overnight at Tambopaxi refuge

Day 7: Ride Back to La Alegria

Today we ride west towards Ruminahui to the highest point of our ride (4,250 m) on the edges of the rocks of the Ruminahui Volcano. We continue our ride toward the green Machachi valley as always guarded by the volcanoes avenue. We cross the Machachi plaza where horsemen are always welcomed. We pass the town of Aloag and arrive to Hacienda La Alegria for a pleasant dinner and to enjoy the hot tub and rest with the memories of the long journeys in the mountains.

Riding: 7+ hours

Day 8: Departure

After breakfast we finish our services. Transfers to the airport or your hotel in Quito.

Sample Itinerary: Chagra Parade - subject to changes

This ride is offered once a year in July when the town of Machachi has its annual Parade. It is a 9-day ride which combines the Volcano Cotopaxi Adventure ride program and includes two extra days at the Chagra Parade (lasso contest and bullfight festivity).

This Parade is a commemoration of Cotopaxi's last eruption and about 2000 Chagras (local cowboy) participate with their horse. This ride is specifically designed for those looking for a cultural immersion and adventure. Chagras (local cowboys) come from different provinces just to be part of this parade and spectators come from all over the country. We will be part of the annual Chagra Parade where riders will understand the importance of the Chagra not only in Machachi, but in Ecuador as well.

On the following day, we will head towards the cloud forest. As we ride through the narrow cloud forest paths we

On the following days, we will head towards the Cloud forest. As we ride through the narrow cloud forest paths we will be surrounded by unique plant and animal species, very different from the ones you will be seeing the next days in the high mountains. One can't help but be amazed by the sheer new environment. We will then ride to Cotopaxi volcano and gallop on the plains at 4000m elevation- The highest center in the world.

Day 1: Arrival

Arrive to the Hacienda early morning (around 9:30am) if you would like the option to ride for 2 or 3 hours.

Day 2: Hacienda La Alegria

Today we ride towards the west through the dairy farms and up to 3500m, working on acclimatizing to the altitude. We continue behind the Viudita mountain (3800m), make a circle to the mountain, and head back to the Hacienda for a late lunch. In the evening, we visit Machachi where you will find lots of options to buy ponchos, hats, and all customs for next day parade.

Riding: 4 hours

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Overnight at Hacienda La Alegria

Day 3: Chagra's Parade

Today we will ride to Machachi (the capital of the Chagras) to honor the Chagras and their culture. You will be part of the Parade that consists of 2 thousand horses in the streets of Machachi. The food, the music, and the colorful dresses and decoration makes the environment very festive. There are hundreds of Chagras dressed with their attire and showing off their horses.

Riding 5 hours

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Overnight at Hacienda La Alegria

Day 4: Lasso Contest and Bullfight

After breakfast you will have the opportunity to attend the Machachi Lasso Contest in the morning and in the afternoon, as an option, you can take a look at the bullfighting festivity that are more like San Fermin in Pamplona.
