Introduction

Dartmoor, England

Attend and be a part of the only cattle drive in the UK!

Whether it is your first time on a drive, or you've done it before, ever rider will play their part in helping out move, muster, and checking cattle. Each day you'll mount up and tend to the cattle depending on their needs and the season. Cattle respond well to being moved by horses as horses are quiet and the and the cattle have a natural respect for them. The horse walks at much the same speed as the cattle and often anticipate the cattle movements. Riders work as a team with most flanking at the sides of the herd with just a couple at the rear, and one or two at the head. There is always a lead cow who the others follow. Ours is called 'Dunny' and is a lighter colour than the rest. She is a young cow, the job used to be her mothers', (same colour) when she was with the herd. Each rider will have a position and a job to do, depending on their ability. Driving cattle is immensely satisfying, doing something that has barely changed for hundreds of years. The type of country we ride over has some breathtaking scenery and varies, through woodland, along valley bottoms, up steep inclines, down steep declines, across rivers, through rock clitter (rock strewn areas) and over hill tops, where you can look down on everything around. Get ready to head 'em up and move 'em out!

Accomodation

Accommodations

This is a stationary ride, so all nights are spent at the same location.

Description

The Castle Inn is a traditional 16th century inn of great character resting on the fringes of Dartmoor National Park. They have a total of 8 bedrooms, all ensuite and privately decorated. All the rooms offer tea and coffee making facilities, hair dryers, flat screen television, bath sheets, hand towels and complimentary toiletries. WIFI is available onsite. The Inn has its own restaurant/pub, where you can order dinner. Laundry is available at the farm for an additional fee.

It is also possible to be accommodated a the farm in one of 2 'shepherd hut'. One has a double bed and the other has two singles, (linen provided). Each are very cozy and come with a wood-burning stove (wood provided), table and chairs. Guests staying 'on farm' also have use of our lodge's kitchen and bathroom etc.

When staying on the far, we provide the ingredients for your breakfast, bread, cereals, milk.

Room Occupancy

Single supplement is mandatory if we are unable to find another rider to share.

Meals

Breakfasts, picnic lunches, and a snack after rides (tea and cakes) are included. Dinners are not included, but guests are free to make use of the Castle's excellent restaurant or eat out elsewhere in the evening. Breakfast will either be at the Inn or the farm while lunch will either be at the farm, a packed lunch, or en-route at one of many fabulous local pubs.

Riding



Riding Level & Terrain

Riders need to be reasonably fit and at least a strong intermediate standard or better. Riders are expected to have ridden several different types of horses and can independently manage a horse's care. Their seat is secure, they are able to control a horse at walk, trot and canter and do not apply unintentional aids to the horse when they







lose balance or become unseated. They know how to rise or post to the trot and ask for and obtain a specific lead or change in lead. They are capable of riding a less experienced horse.

The terrain involves crossing streams, shallow rivers, undulating ground, up and down steep inclines, and would not be suitable for novice or inexperienced riders.

Tack and Riding Style

We normally ride Western, however we can provide English saddles if the guests requests. Our style of riding is very much akin to 'Natural Horsemanship'. We like riders to be relaxed and ride with soft hands.

Horses


We have a selection of fantastic Quarter Horses with calm attitude and appetite for work. All are western trained, very sure-footed and a pleasure to ride. We also have a selection of Irish hunters (some western trained some English style), all a pleasure to ride and cross the terrain with ease. Heights range from 14:3 to 16:2hh.

Guides

The guides are all local moor men or women, who know the moor well. They know where the best crossings are, and where to avoid, as there are areas where it is unsuitable for horses. Some of the guides are members the Dartmoor Rescue Group; some are range clearers for the army on the moor. All are excellent equestrians, and are first-aid trained.

Day 6: Moving Cattle

We will be doing various cattle moving tasks and arrive at the farm in the evening. Riding: 4-5 hours each day Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner Overnight at Castle Inn Lydford

Day 7: Departure

Departure in the morning. Meals included: Breakfast



The work that will be done varies depending on the time of the year:

'Spring cattle turn-out' in May: The cows and autumn born calves are moved from their winter quarters up on to the moor for the summer, a distance of about 8km.

'Bulling cow muster' in June: Some spring calving cows need to be brought down to the farm to run with the bulls for the summer.

'Weaning muster' in July: The cows and calves need to be brought back to the farm for weaning

'<u>Late summer turn-out' in August</u>' The cows that have been running with the bulls for the summer are drove back to Dartmoor

'Cow & calf muster' End of September through October: The freshly calved cows need to come down to better grazing near the Farm as winter approaches.

'Autumn round up' at end of October: All cattle need to be gathered off the moor by 1st November.

Our routine is very much governed by the weather, which can be changeable, occasionally preventing us from going on the moor. During any stay guests are free to take a day out of the saddle, if they wish, and explore the area, the granite way cycle route is 200m from the farm, you can cycle or walk to Okehampton (5km), or just relax and put your feet up. We have 2 acre coarse fishing lake, or crystal clear rivers to bathe in.
