## Introduction

Provence, France  
A Unique Trail in Provence - On the Road of Lavender

A trip itinerary rich in fragrance and color, from the South Luberon to Provencal areas famous for their production of lavender: Plateau of Claparèdes, Plateau of Albion, the Country of Banon, and the foothills of the Lure Mountain. A perfumed trail ride among the lavender, but also sage, widely cultivated in the region. We will ride in the garrigue filled with herbs of Provence. This is a colorful horse riding trip: the white limestone cliffs of the Luberon, the greenery of the pine and oak forests, the ochres of the Provence Colorado, the blue of the sky and lavender... Varied landscapes from Mediterranean Provence to the upper Provence, as far as the foot of the Giant of Provence: the Mont Ventoux.

*Please, note that the peak of the lavender bloom is around mid-July. Harvests generally start mid July. Later, this riding trip remains beautiful, but with less and less blooming lavender fields as the summer progresses.*

## Accommodation

### Accommodations

This is a progressive ride, so you will be staying in different locations during the trip. You will be staying in 4 different locations total.

### Description

Accommodations during the trail will be in guesthouses and country inns. They are basic, but clean. We select our accommodation according to its beautiful setting and friendly atmosphere, for riders to enjoy a pleasant stay. There are no laundry facilities while on trail. All accommodations have WIFI.

If you choose to sleep in dorms, you will spend 1 night in a large dormitory up to twenty people, three nights in 6-people dorms and 2 nights in shared bedrooms.

### Accommodation Itinerary - subject to changes based on availability

- Night 1: Auberge des Seguins in Buoux
- Night 2: Auberge de Rustreou or Le Chateau in Rustrel
- Night 3: Le Petit Labouret in Revest du Bion
- Night 4: Le Mas de Reilhanette in Reilhanette
- Night 5: Les Gargoulettes in Lauris

### Auberge des Seguins in Buoux

This 16th-century stone house building offers a total of 27 rooms plus a dormitory that can host up to 20 people. The rooms are simple but comfortable and all come equipped with heating and free Wi-Fi. Bathrooms can be private or shared depending on the room. There is a garden and an outdoor pool where guests can relax and enjoy the view. There is no cellphone coverage here. Because of the limited number of rooms, in case this accommodation is not available, you will be transferred to Lauris instead.

### Auberge de Rustreou in Rustrel

This old relay station dating back to the 18th century now offers 7 bedrooms equipped with a TV, free Wi-Fi and a private bathroom. Guests can also relax on the outdoor patio.

### Gite Le Chateau in Rustrel

This beautiful 17th-century castle has recently been renovated to offer dormitory style bedrooms (2, 5 and 6 beds in each dormitory) with shared bathrooms. There is free Wi-Fi access in some parts of the Gite.

### Le Petit Labouret in Revest du Bion

This guesthouse provides accommodation in private bedrooms featuring antique furniture and private bathrooms. There is a garden and an outdoor swimming pool where guest can relax and free Wi-Fi access is available anywhere on the property.

### Le Mas de Reilhanette in Reilhanette

This charming stonewall farmhouse offers 5 recently renovated bedrooms. Each bedroom has its own bathroom, air conditioning, a TV and free Wi-Fi access. There is a beautiful garden with some trees, providing the perfect environment to relax.

### Les Gargoulettes in Lauris

Your host welcome you in their lovely country house. Each room has its own theme and decor with air-conditioning, a TV, free Wi-Fi access and ensuite facilities. There is an outdoor swimming pool, a Jacuzzi and a sauna that guests are welcome to use.

### Room Occupancy

Triple occupancy is available at most accommodations. If not available, we can book one double and a single without the supplement.

If traveling as a single rider willing to share and we don't find anyone to share, then the single supplement will apply.





#### Meals

All meals are included in your package and typical Provençal meals are on the menu.

Breakfast will be provided by the accommodations we stay in. It features hot drinks with bread, butter, jam and honey.

At lunch, our assistant will prepare a substantial buffet. A "pastis", a glass of red wine, a barbecue by a mountain stream, a refreshing salad, a nap before leaving again : many small pleasures which will add to the enjoyment of our rides.

In the evening everyone meets around the table, to discover local food - or should we say "cuisine" - don't count on losing any weight.

Wine is included with lunch and dinner for the standard accommodations.

#### Dietary Restrictions

We can cater to dietary restrictions with prior notice.

### Riding

#### Riding Level

In order to make the most of the ride, we require riders to be at ease with walk, trot and canter, in outdoor riding.

#### Pace

This program includes 2/3/5 riding days depending on the option you choose. You will ride an average of 5 hours every day (about 2-3 hours in the morning and again 2-3 hours in the afternoon). The pace will vary according to the terrain.

#### Horses

Most of our horses are Barb and Spanish crosses. They have been trained for trail riding and are sure-footed. They live together as a herd, all year long.

During the ride, we advise you to take care of your horse, in order to get to know him better, and to create a special relationship with him.

#### Riding Group

Groups are made out of 5 to 8 riders. This limited amount of riders, often including several nationalities, allows each person to make the most of the trip.

#### Staff

Two members of staff will accompany you on your trip: 1 guide on horseback who speaks English and French and 1 person in charge of transporting luggage and setting up the lunch buffets.

Guides are certified, and friendly. They made a job out of their passion and enjoy sharing their passion with guests. Whether on the Alpes or on the beaches of Camargue, amongst odorant thym, rosmary and lavender, our guides are here to keep riders safe. All guides speak English.

### Itinerary

#### Sample Itinerary - subject to changes

##### Day 1 (Monday): Lauris to Buoux

Meet in Lauris at 12 pm (noon). You will have an introduction to the trail ride and lunch. In the afternoon, you will be introduced to your horse and will start the trip through the Luberon rolling hills, towards the beautiful perched village of Bonnieux. Some superb residences dating back to the 16th, 17th, and 18th century serve as a reminder that Bonnieux was a wealthy villana when this region, the Comtat Venaissin, belonged to the Papes. Several

Several bishops also chose to live here and as you ride through the village streets you will no doubt marvel at the architecture and history on display. After crossing the picturesque village of Bonnieux, the trail goes down in the Valley of the Aiguebrun.

Overnight in a nice Auberge along the river. Depending on the date, exceptionally, you may be transferred to Lauris for the night.

**Day 2 (Tuesday): Buoux to Rustrel**

This morning you are riding up on the Plateau of Claparède, follow lavender fields, dry stone walls and "bories" (small shepherds' pen). You will cross the cute perched village of Saignon where horses will be able to drink at the fountain in the center of the village. You will then ride down towards the Valley of Apt on ancient paved trails. After lunch, you will ride down in the valley before reaching Rustrel. You will leave your horse in a field before going to your accommodation in the center of the village.

*Overnight at Auberge in Rustrel*

**Day 3 (Wednesday): Rustrel to Revest du Bion**

You quietly get into a valley shaded by oak trees, onto the Albion Plateau, high spot for lavender. Picnic near a chapel before browsing the plateau, former nuclear missiles site for the French nuclear force from 1971 to 1996. Ride among the lavender and sage fields. Arrival at the guesthouse where you can relax and take a swim in the pool before visiting the village of Sault, lavender capital, do some shopping, enjoy a drink on a typical cafe terrasse.

*Overnight at Guesthouse near Revest du Bion*

**Day 4 (Thursday): Revest du Bion to Montbrun-les-Bains**

This morning, you will ride in direction of Saint-Trinit. The lunch will wait for you in the shade near Sault. In the afternoon, you will leave in the direction of Aurel, charming medieval village at the foot of the Mount Ventoux. In the afternoon, the colors of lavenders, fields of cereal and the shadows of the Mount Ventoux may tempt you to imitate the numerous painters who fell in love with this region. You will arrive the afternoon near Montbrun-les-Bains, surrounded with green hills and dominating a plain of perfumed lavenders: one of the most beautiful villages of France.

*Overnight at Guesthouse in Reilhanelte*

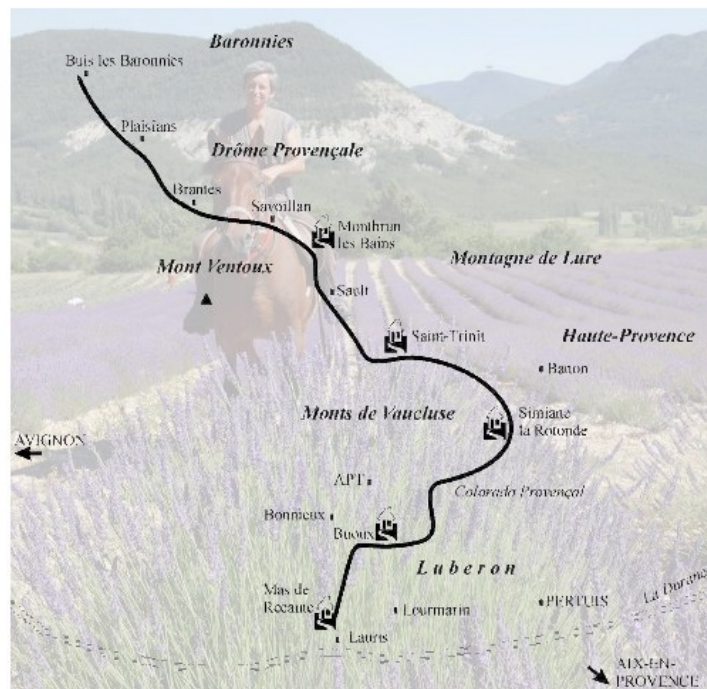
**Day 5 (Friday): Montbrun-les-Bains to Mévouillon**

This morning, you will follow the foot of the Giant of Provence: the Mount Ventoux. We follow the Toulourenc, a pleasant refreshing stream, cross some typical villages, and enter the Drôme Provençale (wooded hills and lavender fields). In the afternoon, we head to Mévouillon, where the truck and minibus await us, for the transfer back to Lauris.

*Overnight at Les Gargoulettes in Lauris*

**Day 6 (Saturday): Departure**

End of the trip after breakfast. Transfers to Aix-en-Provence train stations and Marseille airport.
