## Introduction

Cusco, Peru

This 2-day riding tour is great for those who wish to discover the hidden gems of the Sacred Valley!

You will start your riding adventure from the Pomatales Canyon and make your way to the beautiful waterfall of Perolnityo. Along the way, you will ride through rural communities and learn more about the local way of life. You will also visit a small Inca complex and ride up to a beautiful panoramic viewpoint.

## Accommodation

### Accommodations

You will spend one night camping in the wilderness.



### Camping

We provide everything needed for the camping overnights (tents, sleeping bags...) so no need to bring any special gear. You will sleep in a double cabin tent with 2 'rooms' and a shared entryway. Due to the remote location of our camp, there are no showers or toilets available. It is possible to freshen up in a nearby stream.

### Casa Andina Hotel in Cusco (optional extra night)

This charming hotel is ideally located in the heart of Cusco. It offers 93 comfortable and elegantly decorated rooms, each equipped with a safety box, heating, coffee kit, TV, free Wi-Fi access and a private bathroom with hairdryer. Check-in starts at noon.

### Casa Andina Hotel in Urubamba (optional extra night)

This beautiful hotel located in the Sacred Valley provides rooms that feature cable TV, heating, ensuite bathroom and free Wi-Fi access. The hotel has a small garden where guest can relax in the evening.

### Room Occupancy

In case we are unable to find you a roommate, a single supplement fee might apply. Please, note that accommodation for single travelers are not guaranteed at all locations.



### Meals

All meals are included in your package from lunch on Day 1 to lunch on the last day.





All your meals are prepared by our cook who follows along the tour with our support vehicle (transporting suitcases).

The food served features Peruvian and international cuisine.

The meals are served buffet style so everyone can choose what they want to eat.

Plenty of drinking water will be provided during the rides.

#### Dietary Restrictions

We can cater to most dietary restrictions with advanced notice.

### Riding



For the protection of all participants, the ride leader reserves the right to prevent anyone from riding who displays insufficient ability, or whose behavior endangers the safety of other riders, themselves, or the horses. No refund will be made to a participant who is rejected for any such reason, or who is unwilling or unable to complete a tour.

#### Horses

We have 20 Peruvian Paso horses which are known for their smooth gait and elegance. We have horses with different temperaments that can cater to all levels of rider.

The Peruvian Paso Horse transmits its unique smooth gait to its purebred foals. No artificial devices or special training aids are necessary to enable the horse to perform the "Paso Llano", that provides a ride of incomparable smoothness.

### Itinerary

#### Sample Itinerary - *subject to changes*

##### Day 1: Ride to Rayanniyoc

We transfer you to the "Rasca" bridge located in the heart of the Pomatales canyon at 2895 meters above the sea level. Our guide will give you some information about the horses and the riding style.

We will start riding at about 10 am. We follow a wide and safe route climbing up the mountains until we arrive to the Andean community of "Soqma" located at 3184 meters above sea level.

After visiting Soqma, we will continue climbing until arriving to a second village "Markuray" at 3670 meters above sea level. It is near this village that we expect to have our lunch break (around 1 pm), enjoying a nice view over the valley.

During the afternoon ride, we make our way to "Rayanniyoc" located at 3747 meters above sea level, where we will spend the night.

Once in Rayanniyoc, we will ride downhill a little bit, tie our horses and follow a narrow hiking path to visit the most important waterfall from this area "Perolnuyoc" which is about 100m high. After spending a great time there, we hike to a small Inka complex "Raqay Pata" and enjoy the scenery.

We then head back to our horses and ride up to our camping place. We prepare ourselves and the horses for the cold night. This camping area is located in a gorge that is why when the shadow comes, the temperature descends quickly.

##### Day 2: Sacred Valley Viewpoint

After a quick breakfast (around 8 am), we aim to be back in the saddle for 9:30 am. We will ride up to the highest point of the Sacred Valley, at 4408 meters above the sea level. There, we will enjoy an incredible viewpoint!

After taking some pictures, we will ride downhill through the Soqma Community.

We expect to be back at the trailhead for 1:30 pm. Horses and riders are transferred to our hacienda for a nice farewell lunch (around 2 pm).
