## Introduction

Central Spain, Spain

Join us on a special ride through the famous wine harvest area of Ribera del Duero in Castile.

During the 1990's the region developed into one of the best wine producers of Spain and now showcases some of the country's best wines. The area has 28,000 acres in grape production and is home to over 180 vineyards - over 8000 wine producers buy their grapes from this area! Our horseback tour allows you to explore its bountiful landscapes while you taste some of these classic and delicious wines.

The first two days of the program offer an intense nature experience. You cross parts of the Hoces del Río Duratón Natural Park. In addition to its beautiful nature, this park is notable for its archaeological and historical wealth.

The remaining four days of the ride follow the course of the Duratón river to its mouth, in the Duero. The river gave the Ribera del Duero region its name. This region, with its riverside areas, is part of the gently rolling Castilian plateau and has sandy soils, making it ideal for horseback riding.

In addition to riding, cultural experiences and culinary delights play a crucial role on this trip. Visit old monasteries and castles! Stop by the best bodegas (wine taverns and cellars) in the region, enjoy wine tastings and taste the typical regional specialties such as sheep's cheese and roast lamb!

### Country Hotel (option 1) in Sebúlcór

This small country hotel is composed of different buildings built with local materials and set around a large patio. The rooms are simply furnished and all feature a TV, ensuite facilities and free Wi-Fi access.

### Country Hotel (option 2) in Sebúlcór

This charming country hotel is surrounded by nature and offers tastefully decorated bedrooms. All rooms come equipped with a TV, heating, a private bathroom and free Wi-Fi access. There are also 2 lounges with fireplaces where guest can relax.

### Castillo de Curiel

This beautiful castle-like accommodation offers comfortable bedrooms each decorated with a unique historic style. The bedrooms have a TV, individual air conditioning, a safe, free Wi-Fi and private facilities. There is a small outdoor pool on the rooftop, from which you have a beautiful view over the valley below.

### Hotel in Quintanilla de Onésimo

This accommodation is set in a former flourmill that has been entirely refurbished to ensure a comfortable stay to its guests. The rooms are modern and elegant and all come fitted with a private bathroom, air conditioning, a TV and free Wi-Fi access. The property also has a terrace and a lounge with a fireplace.

### Hotel in Valcavado de Roa

This small hotel is surrounded with vineyards and offer 6 comfortable guest rooms. Each room features air conditioning, heating, private facilities and free Wi-Fi.

### Hotel in Pradorey

This luxurious hotel was built in the Herrerian style by the Duke of Lerma in 1601 to serve as a hunting palace for King Philip III. Today, it offers 18 beautiful rooms with wooden furniture. Each room includes air conditioning, central heating and an ensuite bathroom.

There is an outdoor pool where you can relax in the evening.

## Riding



### Riding Experience

You should be a reasonably experienced rider who is comfortable, secure and in control on a well-schooled horse at a walk, trot and canter in open country and over varied terrain. You should also have a fairly good level of general and riding fitness.

### Pace

The pace is moderate overall but it varies each day. One day in particular, includes some steep ascents, descents and narrow trails to negotiate; other days are on more open terrain, which allows faster riding.

### Horses

We currently have around 20 horses, mainly locally Andalusian, Andalusian crosses and Spanish breeds. They average between 15hh and 16hh and are a forward going, responsive and thoroughly enjoyable ride. They are also good natured, nimble and sure-footed.

The stables where horses live are fully equipped and designed for the comfort and well-being of our horses.

**Sample Itinerary: Standard Option - subject to changes**

**Day 1 (Saturday): Arrival**

Arrival in Madrid, Spain and transfer to the first accommodation. It may be possible depending on the time of arrival, to visit Sepúlveda in the afternoon. It has picturesque town walls, churches and traditionally built houses. Dinner and overnight stay in a beautiful country inn in Sebulcor, near the Las Hoces del Río Duratón Natural Park.

**Day 2 (Sunday): Sebúlcor to San Miquel de Bernuy**

We start our ride along the forest-covered banks of the Duratón, through pine forests and juniper forests. With a bit of luck, you will also meet the only pair of large eagles in the nature park that breed here. Otters, genet cats and other mammals also populate the park.

**Day 4 (Tuesday): Rábano to Curiel**

You ride over the mountains to Penafiel, in the heart of the Duero region, known for its castle and medieval ambience. After a delicious picnic, you will ride through the castle grounds and the bullring. You then continue through heathland to Curiel Castle, where you spend the night today.  
*Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner*  
*Overnight at Castillo de Curiel in Curiel*

**Day 5 (Wednesday): Vale de Cuco Ride**

You will ride around the castle. At the foot of the mountain, there are several wineries, one of which you will visit. Enjoy beautiful views and good riding trails through the wide vineyards.  
*Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner*  
*Overnight at Castillo de Curiel in Curiel*

**Day 6 (Thursday): Curiel to Quantanilla de Onésimo**

You ride back down into the Duero valley to the famous Pasquera winery, which you will visit. You will also see the monastery of Santa Maria de Valbuena. You then continue to Quantanilla de Onesimo, where you spend the night.  
*Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner*  
*Overnight at Hotel in Quantanilla de Onesimo*

**Day 7 (Friday): Duero Vineyards**

Today's ride takes you through the beautiful area of the Duero with vineyards and pine forests. Picnic lunch in the shade of the trees. Afterwards wine tasting and visit to the Abadia Retuerta winery.  
*Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner*  
*Overnight at Hotel in Quantanilla de Onesimo*

**Day 8 (Saturday): Airport transfer**

takes you to another well-known Ribera growing region: Roa. Your destination is a winery with a modern hotel surrounded by vast vineyards.

*Overnight at Hotel in Valcavado de Roa*

**Day 6 (Thursday): Valcavado de Roa to Pradorey**

You continue riding through the beautiful region of Roa to La Ventosilla, which you reach at midday. In the afternoon, you will visit the local Pradorey winery, where you will spend the night in a beautiful hotel. The winery was already highly valued in the 17th century and hosted many well-known guests, including King Felipe III and the painter Rubens. The estate was built in 1601 by the Duke of Lerma in a pompous style.

**Day 7 (Friday): Valduero Winery**

The last day offers you once again special culinary delights with a visit to the Valduero winery, one of the best for Ribera wine. After a great lunch at the estate, in the afternoon you will head back to the Pradorey Hotel and Winery in great spirits, where you can enjoy the beautiful gardens and pool again.
